This year's ritual we will be introducing something new.

We'll be starting earlier with a core group of people to build the shrine and begin to slowly cook our grief to the surface.

We will use some writing practices and some discussion to deepen our grief process. This earlier core group will be meeting at 1:00 pm at the ritual site.

For those who cannot make this earlier time please arrive at 3:00 pm.

The grief ritual will begin at nightfall around 5:30 pm.

- * Please bring warm clothing, candles, blankets, photographs and any sacred objects that connect you to your grief.
- * This is a potluck event, so please bring delicious food to share with all.
- * Please bring a small bit of firewood for the fire, if possible.
- * \$5 - \$10 donation requested to cover cost of port-a-potty.

Directions:

From downtown Ojai continue on hiway 150 to upper Ojai for 6 1/2 miles. Turn right on Sulphur Mountain Road and go 1/4 of a mile to dirt road and turn left. (This turn will be clearly marked by orange cone and sign.) Go another 1/4 of a mile to fork and stay left, then find a place to park.
